

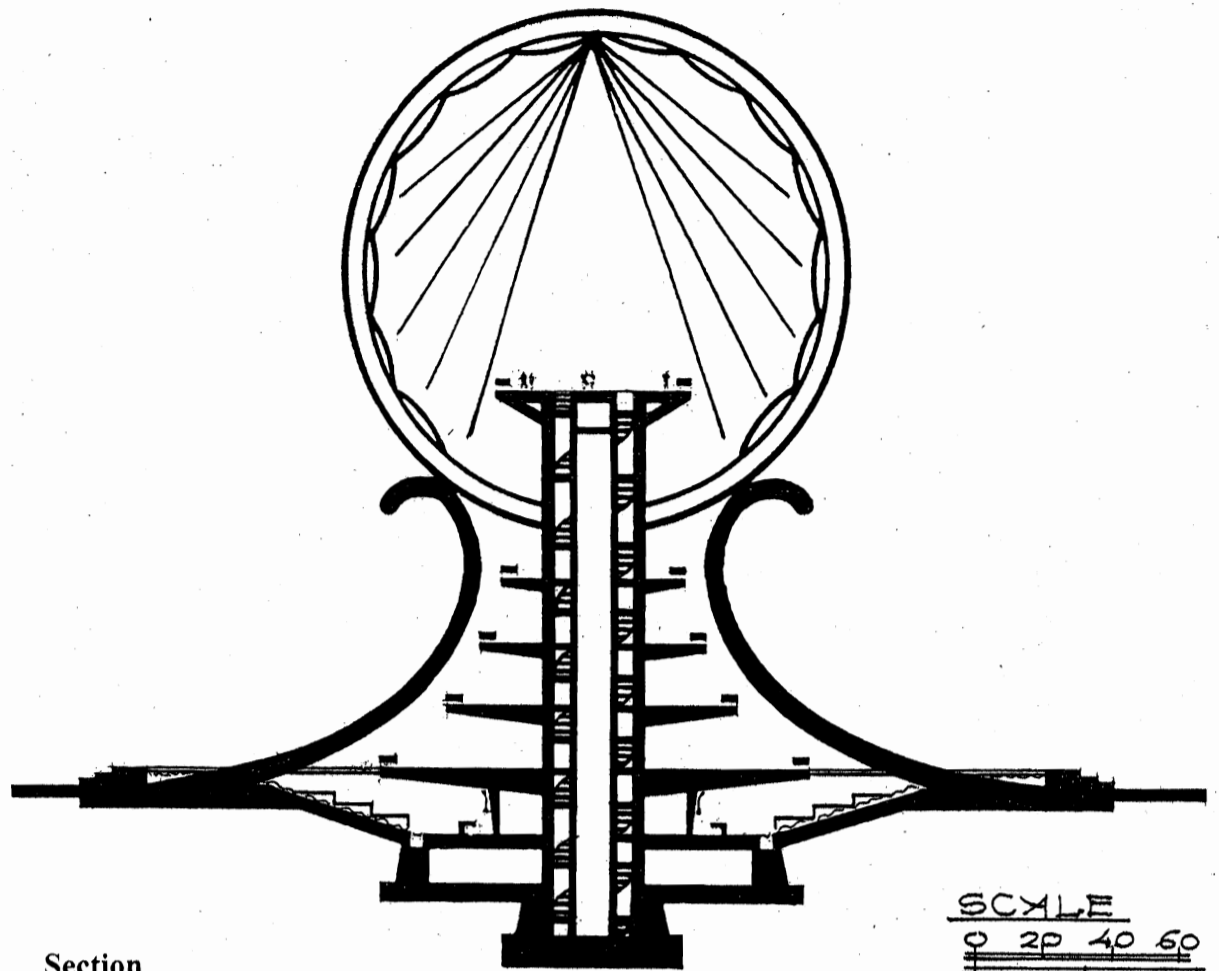
# THE MONUMENT TO THE GREAT NAVIGATORS

This project was designed by the author in 2005 based on his own program, as a not made to order, independent (with no affiliation with any project design firm, without co-authors or assistants) project.

It is assumed that the Monument is located on a seashore in the proximity of a seaport, from which, some famous expeditions departed in the past. The Monument complex consists of the panorama building and the lighthouse. The panorama is positioned in the center of a round pool. The building can be entered via footbridges over the pool throughout its entire perimeter. The museum exposition is located on cantilevered floors; a cafeteria and lounges from which, a round screen for film demonstration can be seen. In the basement, technical and storage spaces are located.

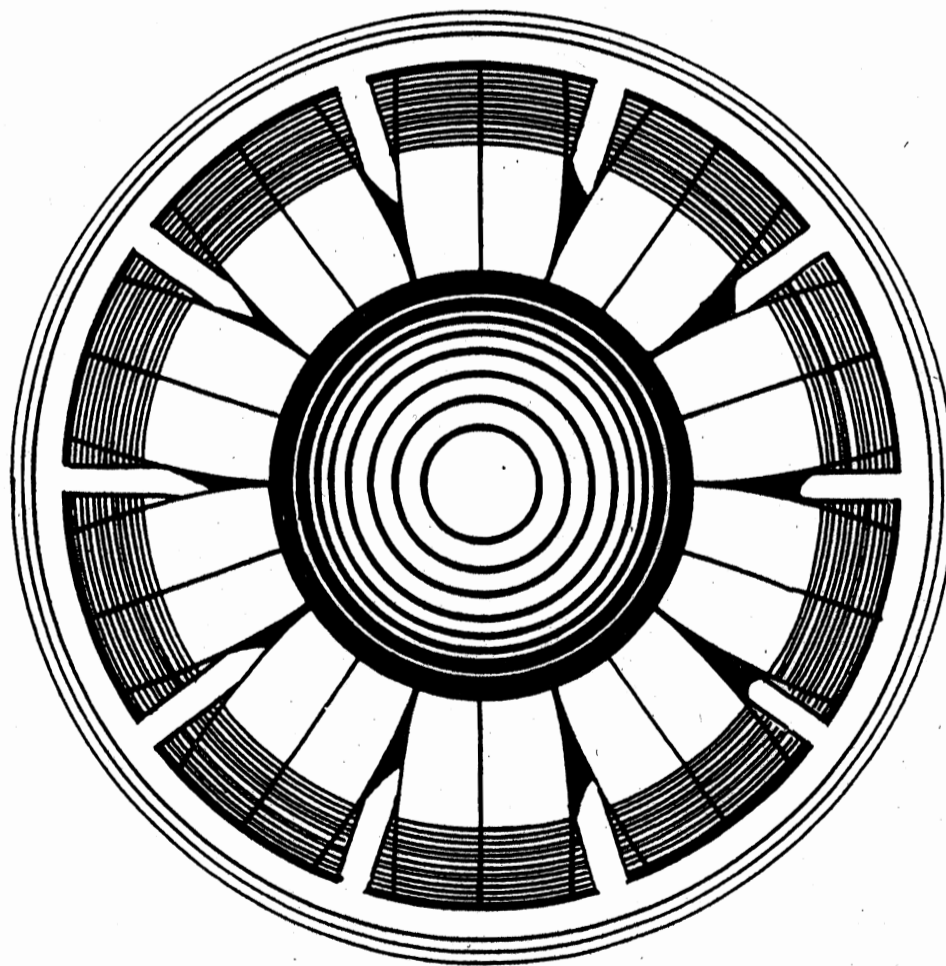
The Globe is made of gilded aluminum, while the other panorama elements and the lighthouse are made of reinforced concrete.

The height of the panorama building - 230 ft (70m); the lighthouse - 345 ft (105 m).
