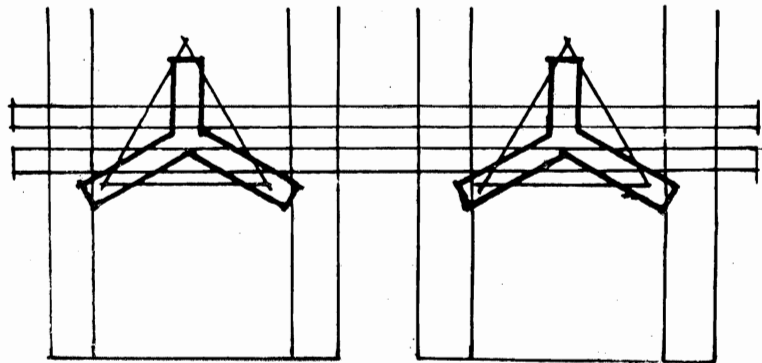
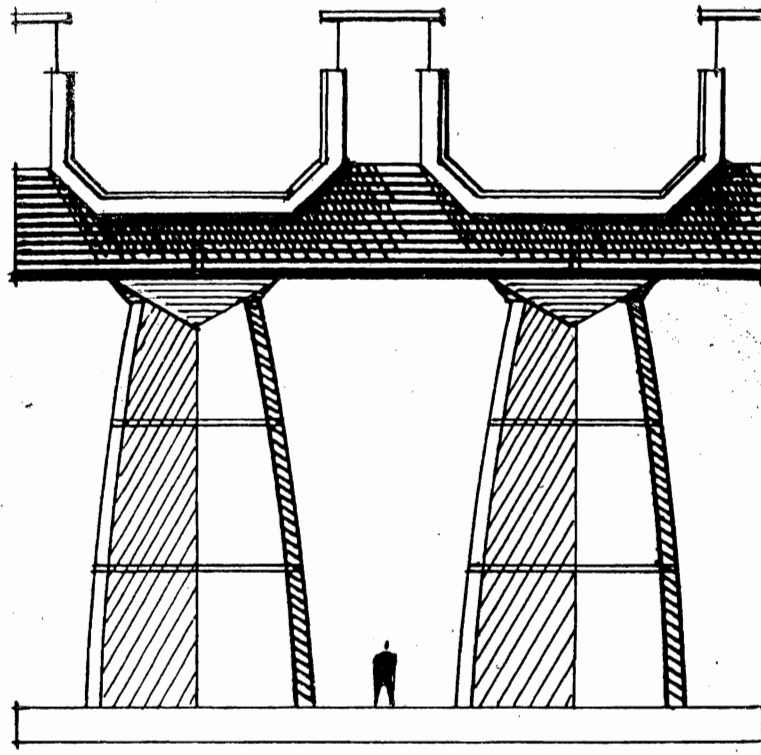


# THE CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURAL ORDER



This project is an attempt to create a new version of one of the basic elements of architecture – the architectural order which would conform to the conditions of contemporary building technology. The aim of this work was the creation of the architectural order in all its comprehensiveness of tectonic and scale characteristics. This architectural order is erected from prefabricated details such as orders of Ancient Greece. But these details are from reinforced concrete, and not from stone. This architectural order is a constructive system, which supports the covering panels with a span of 30 – 60 m. With its relatively small height - 14m (the height of the large ancient architectural order) this architectural order has a very large scale. The intercolumnar, proportions, and contours of forms can be changed in conformance with the features of a given building.
